## **TOP 10 VOTE GETTERS**

1. Install stainless steel sink in kitchen/move plastic sink to BBQ area - 22
2. Cover concrete floor with non-slip finish - 20
3. Build/replace storage shed for pavilion equipment - 16
4. Repair asphalt on cart path at entry to Point – 16 (completed)
5. Add sand to the swimming hole - 13
6. Replace existing pavilion lights with LED lights - 13
7. Create walking path to end of jetty - 11
8. Install light fixture at flagpole to light flag - 11
9. Install WiFi for pavilion and immediate area - 9
10. Install electronic gate key – 8
  - Reset BBQ closer to the swimming hole – 8
  - Install fish cleaning station on fishing pier - 8

## **IDEAS FROM RESIDENTS FOR THE GENERAL NEIGHBORHOOD**

- Dig our ditches in front of homes so they don't flood

## **IDEAS FROM RESIDENTS FOR THE POINT**

## **IDEAS FROM RESIDENTS FOR THE PAVILION**

- Plastic flaps to help prevent wind at the pavilion when necessary
- Weather flaps/covering for pavilion to block wind during events and cold weather.
- Side Panels that can be closed around the pavilion for inclement weather (winter)
- Mini-splits for AC in kitchen
- Ceiling fans for the kitchen, maybe mini split too
- Replace wood picnic tables with folding tables, so they can be moved easily when rented
- Move freezers to the west wall of the pavilion so more space would be available when rented.
- Improve the BBQ area by adding a stainless-steel table, a sink and portable hot water heater.
- Instead of buying new cabinets for storage add locks to several of the kitchen cabinets we already have.

## **IDEAS FROM RESIDENTS FOR THE SWIMMING HOLE**

- Add a small platform to existing ladder site on bulkhead (ladder is in a great location).
- Add rope swing. Support beams can be installed so as not to interfere with docking boats and watercraft.

## **IDEAS FROM RESIDENTS FOR THE BOAT RAMP**

- Extend one or both piers so that more boats can be docked at one time. Not enough room!!!
